PSALMS OF THANKSGIVING TO OUR GOD

with Explanation to First article of Apostles' Creed

You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet" 8:3-6
- L "O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise." 8:1-2
- R "The Lord is my Shepherd," 23

ALL also clothing and shoes, meat and drink, house and home, wife and children, fields, cattle and all my goods,

- L "He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day...for he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;" 91:4-5, 11
- **R** "The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold." 18:2

- L "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name." 100:4
- **R** "But as for me, I will always have hope; I will praise you more and more. My mouth will tell of your salvation all day long, though I know not its measure." 71:14-15
- L "and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever." 23
